#### University of Minnesota Crookston Scholarship Renewed

Over the past several years, The University of Minnesota Crookston has had a private donor who has made significant financial donations for scholarships for students who graduate from specific area high schools. This scholarship is automatically awarded to any student attending the University of Minnesota Crookston who has graduated from Clearbrook-Gonvick, Grygla, Goodridge, and Red Lake Falls. This scholarship is renewed annually and the decision was recently made for it to continue for the 2025-2026 school year. The purpose of these funds are to cover the costs of tuition and fees. This means that each student who enrolls could receive up to \$13,000/year.

<u>Purpose:</u> For Students from these communities to earn their degree from UMN Crookston and graduate with no, or minimal debt.

What to Expect: Your FAFSA will automatically be sent to Crookston once you are admitted. Once your FAFSA information is received by the school, you will be offered any federal, state, and institutional aid you are eligible to receive. The above private donor scholarship will automatically be awarded to you, no scholarship application required.
